C R D E R

As per the Government Order 1st and 2nd read above,
orders were issued sanctioning immediate grant of Rs. 5000/-
and Rs. 1000/- to Rs. 5000/- as ex-gratia to the wounded, personnel
who participated in military operations, by the State Government
from the year 1962. In 1971, the State Government extended the
benefit to the personnel belonging to Kerala. However this was
not extended to the subsequent war operations. The Central
Government is granting Rs. 2 lakhs each as ex-gratia to the
personnel of Central Para Military Forces. Following this
certain other states have also sanctioned certain financial help
to the personnel of Central Para Military Forces if killed within
these states. The Director General, BSF, Union Home Ministry has
requested this State to consider the functioning of financial
assistance.

It is a fact that the personnel of Central Para Military
Forces who are killed in action deserve sympathy and consideration
since they sacrifice life for the Nation. Hence the proposal
was considered by the State Government for granting ex-gratia
amount to the personnel of the Central Para Military Forces who
belong to Kerala and also those who are killed/disabled belonging
to other state, while serving in Kerala, at the rate of Rs.5000/-.

The estimated expenditure for payment of the amount to the
casualties during the last five years is Rs. 1 lakh and thereafter
a recurring amount of Rs. 25000/- is necessary annually for
implementing the scheme.

In the above circumstances, Government are pleased
to order that an amount of Rs. 5000/- will be paid as ex-gratia

who belong to other states.


The necessary amount for implementing the
