Sub:- Welfare of Ex- Servicemen - 50% Reservation in Havildar /Head Constable Posts in Armed Police Battalions for Ex- Servicemen - Regarding.
Ref:- Your Letter No:2569/Emp-1/09/DSW dated 06/04/2009.

Inviting attention to the reference cited, I am to inform you that Government have examined the proposal for 50% Reservation in Havildar/ Head Constable posts in Armed Police Battalions for Ex- Servicemen in detail. Proposal for reservation of 50% of the Head Constable vacancies cannot be considered since it will badly affect the promotional aspects of Police Constables in Armed Police Battalions. An age relaxation upto the age of 40 years is already allowed for Ex- Servicemen for direct recruitment as Police Constables in Armed Police Battalions through Public Service Commission and 10% quota is allowed for the recruitment of Driver Police Constables. These relaxations are sufficient for Ex- Servicemen to get an opportunity in Police Department.

In the above circumstances your request cannot be considered and hence rejected.
