*Abstract.*—Recognition of qualifications—Ex-Servicemen holding army I Class and II Class Certificates as equivalent to S.S.L.C. and Standard VIII—Eligibility for appointment in Public Services—Orders issued.

ORDER

1. Government, after consulting the Kerala Public Service Commission, order that Ex-Servicemen having 15 years service and holding Indian Army I Class Certificate will be eligible for appointment to posts for which the minimum educational qualification is S.S.L.C. provided they have passed VII Standard in their civil education. Such persons will be required to pass the test in mother tongue within the period of probation, if they have not passed this earlier.

2. Government also order that Ex-servicemen having 15 years service and holding Indian Army Certificate of Education II Class will be treated as having passed Standard VIII for appointment in public services.
